Providing a service to the people of Perth and surrounding areas

This is done by:

- ✚ Providing furniture at reasonable prices to anyone who comes in.
- ✚ Providing furniture at discounted prices for anyone on benefits whether by self-referral, or referred by social services or other support agency.
- ✚ Providing work placement opportunities in conjunction with the local Volunteer Centre.
